

John 8:

- 1 But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.
- 2 And early in the morning He came again into the temple, and **all the people came to Him**, and He sat down and taught them.

John 8:

- 3 And the scribes and Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the midst,
- 4 They said to Him, Teacher, this woman has been caught committing adultery, in the very act.
- 5 Now in the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women.
What then do you say?

John 8:

- 6 But **they** said this to tempt Him, so that **they** might have *reason* to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote with His finger on the ground.
- 7 But when they persisted in questioning Him, He stood up and said to them, **He who is without sin among you, let him *be the first to throw a stone at her.***
- 8 And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground.
- 9 And when **they** heard *that*, **they** went out one by one, **beginning with the older ones**. And Jesus was left alone, and **the woman** *stood* where **she** was, in the midst.

John 8:

- 10 And Jesus stood up and said to her, Woman, where are they?
Has no one condemned you?
- 11 And she said, No one, Lord. And Jesus said, Neither do I
condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more.

John 8:

- 12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to **them**, saying, **I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.**



Who and where (in the temple)	Do what	What Jesus did	Response
All the people (v.2)	Came to Jesus	Sat down and taught them	
Scribes and Pharisees (v.3)	Brought a woman caught in adultery to Jesus and tempted Him. In the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. <i>What then do you say?</i> (v.5)	Jesus stooped down and wrote with His finger on the ground. (v.6)	
Scribes and Pharisees (v.7)	Persisted in questioning Him. (v.7)	He stood up and said to them, <i>He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her.</i> (v.7) Again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. (v.8)	they went out one by one, beginning with the older ones. (v.9)
A woman caught in adultery (v.3)	Were brought to Jesus and might be very frightened (could be stoned to death) (v.3)	Jesus stood up and said to her, <i>Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?</i> (v.10) And she said, No one, Lord. And Jesus said, <i>Neither do I condemn you;</i> go, and from now on <i>sin no more.</i> (v.11)	Stayed with Jesus (v.9)

John 8:

- 12 Again therefore Jesus spoke to **them**, saying, **I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall by no means walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.**



John 8:

13 The Pharisees then said to Him, You are testifying concerning Yourself; Your [testimony](#) is not true.

How did Jesus testify His testimony?

How do we testify our testimonies?

John 8:

- 14 Jesus answered and said to them, Even if I testify concerning Myself, My testimony is true, **for I know where I came from and where I am going**; but you do not know where I come from or where I am going.
- 15 **You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one.**
- 16 But even if I do judge, My judgment is true, **for I am not alone, but I and the Father who sent Me.**
- 17 And in your law also it has been written that the testimony of two men is true:
- 18 **I am One who testifies concerning Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies concerning Me.**

John 8:

19 They said then to Him, Where is Your **Father**? Jesus answered, You know neither Me nor My Father; **if you knew Me, you would know My Father also.**

20 These words He spoke in the treasury as He taught in the temple; and no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come.

Example of testimony by Jesus

To Jesus	To us (during our testimonies)
1. for I know where I came from and where I am going. (v.14)	Phil.3:12 Not that I have already obtained or am already perfected, but I pursue, if even I may lay hold of that for which I also have been laid hold of by Christ Jesus. Phil.3:14 I pursue toward the goal for the prize to which God in Christ Jesus has called <i>me</i> upward.
2. for I am not alone, but I and the Father who sent Me. (v.16)	We need to have the Lord's presence
3. the Father who sent Me testifies concerning Me. (v.18)	Lord has to testify for us.
4. if you knew Me, you would know My Father also. (v.19)	We need to know God the Father through Jesus Christ
5. He taught in the temple; and no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come. (v20)	We need to know the proper timing of making testimony.
