


# Man : Body, Soul and Spirit

**1 Thessalonians 5:23** And the God of peace Himself sanctify you wholly, and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**Romans 8:6** For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the spirit is life and peace.

**Hebrews 4:12** For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.



## Body:

- 1 Corinthians 6:19** Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?
- 1 Corinthians 15:44** It is sown a soulish body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a soulish body, there is also a spiritual one.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:4** That each one of you know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor,
- Romans 8:23** And not only so, but we ourselves also, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan in ourselves, eagerly awaiting sonship, the redemption of our body.
- Romans 12:1** I exhort you therefore, brothers, through the compassions of God to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, well pleasing to God, *which is* your reasonable service.
- James 2:26** For just as the body without the spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead.

# Flesh:

**Genesis 6:3** And Jehovah said, My Spirit will not strive with man forever, for he indeed is flesh; so his days will be one hundred twenty years.

**Ezekiel 36:26** I will also give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you; and I will take away the heart of stone out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.

**John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality.

**Roman 8:5** For those who are according to the flesh mind the things of the flesh; but those who are according to the spirit, the things of the Spirit.

**Galatians 5:17** For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these oppose each other that you would not do the things that you desire.

**1 Peter 1:24** For "all flesh is like grass, and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass has withered, and the flower has fallen off,

**1 John 2:16** Because all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes and the vainglory of life, is not of the Father but is of the world.

## **Soul: Mind**

**Mark 12:30** And you shall love the Lord your God from your whole heart and from your whole soul and from your whole mind and from your whole strength."

**Romans 12:2** And do not be fashioned according to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of the mind that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and well pleasing and perfect.

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God has not given us a spirit of cowardice, but of power and of love and of sobermindedness.

**1 Peter 3:8** And finally be all of the same mind, sympathetic, loving the brothers, tenderhearted, humble-minded;

## **Soul: Will**

**Romans 7:18** For I know that in me, that is, in my flesh, nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but to work out the good is not.

**Philippians 2:13** For it is God who operates in you both the willing and the working for *His* good pleasure.

**2 Timothy 3:12** And indeed all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

**1 Peter 4:3** For the time which has passed is sufficient *for you* to have carried out the desire of the Gentiles, having gone on in licentiousness, lusts, debaucheries, carousings, drinking bouts, and lawless idolatries.

## **Soul: Emotion; Affection**

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God has not given us a spirit of cowardice, but of power and of love and of sobermindedness.

**Luke7:38** And she stood behind *Him* at His feet weeping and began to wet His feet with her tears and wiped *them* with the hair of her head, and she kissed His feet affectionately and anointed *them* with the ointment.

**Luke15:20** And he rose up and came to his own father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was moved with compassion, and he ran and fell on his neck and kissed him affectionately.

**Acts 20:31** Therefore watch, remembering that for three years, night and day, I did not cease admonishing each one with tears.

# Spirit: Conscience

**Acts 23:1** And Paul, looking intently at the Sanhedrin, said, Men, brothers, I have conducted myself in all good conscience before God until this day.

**Acts 24:16** Because of this I also exercise myself to always have a conscience without offense toward God and men.

**Romans 9:1** I speak the truth in Christ, I do not lie, my conscience bearing witness with me in the Holy Spirit,

**1 Corinthians 8:12** And sinning in this way against the brothers and wounding their weak conscience, you sin against Christ.

**1 Corinthians 10:25** Everything sold in a meat market eat, asking no questions for conscience' sake;

**1 Corinthians 10:27** If any of the unbelievers invites you and you wish to go, eat everything that is set before you, asking no question for conscience' sake.

**2 Corinthians 1:12** For our boasting is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in singleness and sincerity of God, not in fleshly wisdom but in the grace of God, we have conducted ourselves in the world, and more abundantly toward you.

**2 Corinthians 4:2** But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor adulterating the word of God, but by the manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every conscience of men before God.

# Spirit: Conscience

- 1 Timothy 1:5** But the end of the charge is love out of a pure heart and *out of* a good conscience and *out of* unfeigned faith;
- 1 Timothy 1:19** Holding faith and a good conscience, *concerning* which some, thrusting *these* away, have become shipwrecked regarding the faith;
- 1 Timothy 3:9** Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
- 2 Timothy 1:3** I thank God, whom I serve from *my* forefathers in a pure conscience, while unceasingly I have remembrance concerning you in my petitions night and day,
- Titus 1:15** This you know, that all who are in Asia turned away from me, of whom are Phygelus and Hermogenes.
- Hebrews 9:14** How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
- Hebrews 10:22** Let us come forward to *the Holy of Holies* with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.
- Hebrews 13:18** Pray for us, for we are persuaded that we have a good conscience, desiring in all things to conduct ourselves honorably.
- 1 Peter 3:16** Yet with meekness and fear, having a good conscience, so that in the matter in which you are spoken against, those who revile your good manner of life in Christ may be put to shame.
- 1 Peter 3:21** Which *water*, as the antitype, also now saves you, *that is*, baptism, not a putting away of the filth of the flesh but the appeal of a good conscience unto God, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

## **Spirit: Intuition**

**John 21:6,7** He said to them, “Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some.” So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in, because of the quantity of fish. **That disciple whom Jesus loved therefore said to Peter, “It is the Lord!”** When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he put on his outer garment, for he was stripped for work, and threw himself into the sea.

**1 Corinthians 2:11** For who among men knows the things of man, except the spirit of man which is in him? In the same way, the things of God also no one has known except the Spirit of God.

## Spirit: Intuition

### Acts 16:

- 16:1** And he came also to Derbe and to Lystra. And behold, a certain disciple named Timothy was there, the son of a Jewish woman *who was a believer*, but of a Greek father;
- 16:2** He was well attested to by the brothers in Lystra and Iconium.
- 16:3** Paul wanted this one to go forth with him; and he took *him* and circumcised him because of the Jews who were in those places, for they all knew that his father was a Greek.
- 16:4** And as they went through the cities, they delivered to them the decrees to keep which had been decided upon by the apostles and elders in Jerusalem.
- 16:5** And so the churches were strengthened in the faith and increased in number daily.
- 16:6** And they passed through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in Asia.
- 16:7** And when they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, yet the Spirit of Jesus did not allow them.
- 16:8** And bypassing Mysia, they came down to Troas.

# Spirit: Fellowship

**Acts 2:42** And they continued steadfastly in the teaching and the fellowship of the apostles, in the breaking of bread and the prayers.

**1 Corinthians 10:16** The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the fellowship of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the fellowship of the body of Christ?

**2 Corinthians 8:4** With much entreaty they besought of us the grace and the fellowship of the ministry to the saints;

**2 Corinthians 13:14** The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

**Philippians 2:1** If there is therefore any encouragement in Christ, if any consolation of love, if any fellowship of spirit, if any tenderheartedness and compassions,

**1 John 1:3** That which we have seen and heard we report also to you that you also may have fellowship with us, and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.
